1) Israelites Scattered and Hated

“Behold, I will make you small among the nations, you shall be utterly despised.” (Obadiah 1:2)

“Moreover I will make you a desolation and an object of reproach among the nations round about you and in the sight of all that pass by. You shall be a reproach and a taunt, a warning and a horror, to the nations round about you, when I execute judgments on you in anger and fury, and with furious chastisements. “And I will scatter you among the nations, and I will unsheathe the sword after you; and your land shall be a desolation, and your cities shall be a waste.” (Leviticus 26:33)

“I will scatter them among the nations whom neither they nor their fathers have known; and I will send the sword after them, until I have consumed them.” (Jeremiah 9:16)

“And they shall know that I am Yahweh, when I disperse them among the nations and scatter them through the countries.” (Ezekiel 12:15)

“Moreover I swore to them in the wilderness that I would scatter them among the nations and disperse them through the countries.” (Ezekiel 20:23)

“He gave them into the hand of the nations, so that those who hated them ruled over them.” (Psalm 106:41)

2) Scattered Israelites Gathered Back Together

“...I will for their sake remember the covenant with their forefathers, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God. I am Yahweh.” (Leviticus 26:45)

“...I will leave some of you alive. When you have among the nations some who escape the sword, and when you are scattered through the countries, then those of you who escape will remember me among the nations where they are carried captive...” (Ezekiel 6:8-9)

“But in Mount Zion there shall be those that escape, and it shall be holy; and the house of Jacob shall possess their own possessions.” (Obadiah 1:17)

“I will be found by you, says Yahweh, and I will restore your fortunes and gather you from all the nations and all the places where I have driven you, says Yahweh, and I will bring you back to the place from which I sent you into exile.” (Jeremiah 29:14)

“Though I scattered them among the nations, yet in far countries they shall remember me, and with their children they shall live and return.” (Zechariah 10:9)

“For I will take you from the nations, and gather you from all the countries, and bring you into your own land.” (Ezekiel 36:24)

“Yahweh will have compassion on Jacob and will again choose Israel, and will set them in their own land, and aliens will join them and will cleave to the house of Jacob.” (Isaiah 14:1)

“...For I will bring them back to their own land which I gave to their fathers.” (Jeremiah 16:15)

“Thus says Yahweh God: When I gather the house of Israel from the peoples among whom they are scattered, and manifest my holiness in them in the sight of the nations, then they shall dwell in their own land which I gave to my servant Jacob.” (Ezekiel 28:25)

“They shall no more be a prey to the nations, nor shall the beasts of the land devour them; they shall dwell securely, and none shall make them afraid. And I will provide for them prosperous plantations so that they shall no more be consumed with hunger in the land, and no longer suffer the reproach of the nations.” (Ezekiel 34:28-29)

“...as Yahweh lives who brought up and led the descendants of the house of Israel out of the north country and out of all the countries where he had driven them ... they shall dwell in their own land.” (Jeremiah 23:8)

“And I will bring them out from the peoples, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them into their own land; and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the fountains, and in all the inhabited places of the country.” (Ezekiel 34:13)

“There is hope for your future, says Yahweh, and your children shall come back to their own country.” (Jeremiah 31:17)

“Behold, I will take the people of Israel from the nations among which they have gone, and will gather them from all sides, and bring them to their own land...” (Ezekiel 37:21)

“Then they shall know that I am Yahweh their God because I sent them into exile among the nations, and then gathered them into their own land. I will leave none of them remaining among the nations any more...” (Ezekiel 39:28)

“At that time I will gather you; at that time I will bring you home. I will give you honor and praise among all the peoples of the earth when I restore your fortunes before your very eyes, says Yahweh.” (Zephaniah 3:20)

3) Hatred of Israelites to Become Illegal

“He who blasphemes the name of Yahweh shall be put to death ... the sojourner as well as the native, when he blasphemes the name, shall be put to death.” (Leviticus 24:15-16)

“... Not a man moved his tongue against any of the people of Israel...” (Joshua 10:21)

“Therefore I make a decree: Any people, nation or language that speaks anything against [Yahweh] the god of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego shall be torn limb from limb and their houses laid in ruins...” (words of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon - Daniel 3:29)

“... and I’ll set a place for my people, for Israel, and plant them, and they’ll settle in their place and not be distressed anymore, and unjust men will never degrade them again...” (2Samuel 7:10)

“Praise his people (the Israelites), O you nations; for he avenges the blood of his servants, and takes vengeance on his adversaries, and makes expiation for the land of his people.” (Deuteronomy 32:43)

“...and I will not let you hear any more the reproach of the nations, and you shall no longer bear the disgrace of the peoples ...” (Ezekiel 36:15)

“My accusers will be clothed with disgrace, and wrapped in shame as in a cloak.” (Psalm 109:29)

“Therefore, as surely as I live...Moab will become like Sodom, the Ammonites like Gomorrah...The remnant of my people will plunder them. The survivors of my nation will inherit their land. This is what they will get in return for their pride, for insulting and mocking the people of Yahweh Almighty. Yahweh will be terrible against them...” (Zephaniah 2:9-11)

4) The Messiah-King over Jerusalem and the World

“But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose origin is from of old, from ancient days ... And he shall stand and feed his flock in the strength of Yahweh, in the majesty of the name of Yahweh his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. And he will be their peace.” (Micah 5:2, 4)

“Their prince shall be one of themselves, their ruler shall come forth from their midst; I will make him draw near, and he shall approach me, for who would dare of himself to approach me? says Yahweh.” (Jeremiah 30:21)

“...and I will establish his kingdom. He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever...” (2 Samuel 7:12-13)

“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulder, and his name will be called “Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.” Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of Yahweh of hosts will do this.” (Isaiah 9:6-7)

“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Lo, your king comes to you; triumphant and victorious is he, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt the foal of a donkey...” (Zechariah 9:9)

“And to him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.” (Daniel 7:14)

“He will execute judgment among the nations, filling them with corpses; he will shatter chiefs over the wide earth.” (Psalm 110:6)

5) Middle East to be Cleared of Non-Israelites

“And I will give to you, and to your descendants after you, the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession...” (Genesis 17:8)

“Yahweh said to Abram ...: Lift up your eyes from where you are and look north and south, east and west. All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring forever. I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that if anyone could count the dust, then your offspring could be counted. Go, walk through the length and breadth of the land, for I am giving it to you.” (Genesis 13:14-17)

“He also said to him: I am Yahweh, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to take possession of it.” (Genesis 15:7)

“... I am Yahweh, the god of your father Abraham, and the god of Isaac. I will give you and your descendants the land on which you are lying. Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east, to the north and to the south. All peoples on earth will be blessed through you and your offspring. I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I promised you.” (Genesis 28:13-15)

“And God said to him: I am God Almighty. Be fruitful and increase in number. A nation and a community of nations will come from your body. The land I gave to Abraham and Isaac I also give to you, and I will give this land to your descendants afterward.” (Genesis 35:11-12)

“I also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they dwelt as sojourners ... Say therefore to the people of Israel, ‘I am Yahweh, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians...and I will take you for my people, and I will be your God ... And I will bring you into the land which I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; I will give it to you for a possession. I am Yahweh.’” (Exodus 6:4-8)

“And when Yahweh brings you into the land of the Canaanites, as he swore to you and your fathers, and shall give it to you...” (Exodus 13:11)

“Your territory will extend from the [Sinai] desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates - all the Hittite country - to the Great Sea [Mediterranean] on the west.” (Joshua 1:4)

“I will establish your borders from the Red Sea [Sinai] to the Sea of the Philistines [Mediterranean], and from the [Sinai] desert to the river [Euphrates]. I will hand over to you the people who live in the land, and you will drive them out before you. Do not make a covenant with them or with their gods. Do not let them live in your land, or they will cause you to sin against me...” (Exodus 23:31-33)

“When Yahweh your God brings you into the land which you are entering to take possession of it, and clears away many nations before you ... and when Yahweh your God gives them over to you, and you defeat them; then you must utterly destroy them; you shall make no covenant with them, and show no mercy to them. You shall not make marriages with them, giving your daughters to their sons or taking their daughters for your sons. For they would turn away your sons from following me, to serve other gods; then the anger of Yahweh would be kindled against you, and he would destroy you quickly. But thus shall you deal with them: you shall break down their altars, and dash in pieces their pillars, and hew down their Asherim, and burn their graven images with fire. For you are a people holy to Yahweh your God; Yahweh your God has chosen you to be a people for his own possession, out of all the peoples that are on the face of the earth.” (Deuteronomy 7:1-6)

“When you draw near to a city to fight against it, offer terms of peace to it. And if its answer to you is peace and it opens to you, then all the people who are found in it shall do forced labor for you and shall serve you. But if it makes no peace with you, but makes war against you, then you shall besiege it; and when Yahweh your God gives it into your hand you shall put all its males to the sword, but the women and the little ones, the cattle, and everything else in the city, all its spoil, you shall take as booty for yourselves; and you shall enjoy the spoil of your enemies, which Yahweh your God has given you. Thus you shall do to all the cities which are very far from you, which are not cities of the nations here. But in the cities of these peoples that Yahweh your God gives you for an inheritance, you shall save alive nothing that breathes, but you shall utterly destroy them ... that they may not teach you to do according to all their abominable practices which they have done in the service of their gods, and so to sin against Yahweh your God.” (Deuteronomy 20:10-18)

“Speak to the Israelites and say to them: When you cross the Jordan into Canaan, drive out all the inhabitants of the land before you. Destroy all their carved images and their cast idols, and demolish all their high places. Take possession of the land and settle in it, for I have given you the land to possess. Distribute the land by lot, according to your clans. To a larger group give a larger inheritance, and to a smaller group a smaller one. Whatever falls to them by lot will be theirs. Distribute it according to your ancestral

tribes. But if you do not drive out the inhabitants of the land, those you allow to remain will become barbs in your eyes and thorns in your sides. They will give you trouble in the land where you will live.” (Numbers 33:50-55)

“For Gaza shall be deserted, and Ashkelon shall become a desolation; Ashdod's people shall be driven out at noon, and Ekron shall be uprooted ... The word of Yahweh is against you, O Canaan, land of the Philistines; and I will destroy you till no inhabitant is left. And you, O seacoast, shall be pastures, meadows for shepherds and folds for flocks. The seacoast shall become the possession of the remnant of the house of Judah, on which they shall pasture, and in the houses of Ashkelon they shall lie down at evening. ... Moab shall become like Sodom, and the Ammonites like Gomorrah, a land possessed by nettles and salt pits, and a waste for ever. The remnant of my people shall plunder them, and the survivors of my nation shall possess them ... Yahweh will be terrible against them; yea, he will famish all the gods of the earth, and to him shall bow down, each in its place, all the lands of the nations. You also, O Ethiopians, shall be slain by my sword. And he will stretch out his hand against the north, and destroy Assyria; and he will make Nineveh a desolation, a dry waste like the desert. Herds shall lie down in the midst of her, all the beasts of the field; the vulture and the hedgehog shall lodge in her capitals; the owl shall hoot in the window, the raven croak on the threshold; for her cedar work will be laid bare.” (Zephaniah 2:4-7, 9, 11-14)

6) Future Permanent Safety for Israelites

“From Zion, perfect in beauty, God shines forth.” (Psalm 50:2)

“May he send you help from the sanctuary and grant you support from Zion.” (Psalm 20:2)

“So Israel will live in safety alone. Jacob's spring is secure in a land of grain and new wine, where the heavens drop dew.” (Deuteronomy 33:28)

“My people will live in peaceful dwelling places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.” (Isaiah 32:18)

“It will be inhabited; never again will it be destroyed. Jerusalem will be secure.” (Zechariah 14:11)

7) Israelites Become “Priests” to the Rest of the World

The priest, according to Bible rules, did no work aside from various silly priest duties, and he was supported entirely by the general population. Priests couldn't be drafted into the army but were instead responsible for running the temple (Numbers 1:45-53). They did, however, order the army to battle. The priest Eleazar told Joshua and his army when to fight and with whom (Numbers 27:18-21). The priest Samuel ordered a mass murder

of Amalekites, and when King Saul didn't murder everyone he was supposed to, Samuel fired him and hacked up the Amalekite king himself (1Samuel 15:1-35). When the priest Elisha traveled, he regularly stayed overnight at the home of a particular woman. Elisha told his assistant to offer the woman a gift to repay her (2Kings 4:8-12). His offer was that he could speak to the king or the head of the army for her, in case she needed their help for anything (2K 4:13).

Priests got free land (Numbers 35:1-33 / Joshua 21:1-45) and all the best food and materials (Leviticus 7:28-36 / Numbers 18:6-30 / Deuteronomy 18:1-4).

They placed values (animals and cash) on men's sins, and then collected the payments, which they kept for themselves in the temple. Gold taken from enemy tribes was given to the priests.

"When all the work King Solomon had done for the temple of Yahweh was finished, he brought in the things his father David had dedicated - the silver and gold and the furnishings - and he placed them in the treasuries of Yahweh's temple." (1 Kings 7:51)

"When all the work Solomon had done for the temple of Yahweh was finished, he brought in the things his father David had dedicated - the silver and gold and all the furnishings - and he placed them in the treasuries of God's temple." (Chronicles 5:1)

"He [Solomon] brought into the temple of Yahweh the silver and gold and the articles that he and his father had dedicated." (1 Kings 15:15)

(David:) "I have taken great pains to provide for the temple of Yahweh a hundred thousand talents [app3,750 tons] of gold, a million talents [app 37,500 tons] of silver, quantities of bronze and iron too great to be weighed, and wood and stone." (1Chronicles 22:14)

(Joash Repairs the Temple)

"Joash was seven years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem forty years. His mother's name was Zibiah; she was from Beersheba. Joash did what was right in the eyes of Yahweh all the years of Jehoiada the priest. Jehoiada chose two wives for him, and he had sons and daughters. Some time later Joash decided to restore the temple of Yahweh. He called together the priests and Levites and said to them, "Go to the towns of Judah and collect the money due annually from all Israel, to repair the temple of your God. Do it now." But the Levites did not act at once. Therefore the king summoned Jehoiada the chief priest and said to him, "Why haven't you required the Levites to bring in from Judah and Jerusalem the tax imposed by Moses the servant of Yahweh and by the assembly of Israel for the Tent of the Testimony?"

Now the sons of that wicked woman Athaliah had broken into the temple of God and had used even its sacred objects for the Baals. At the king's command, a chest was made and placed outside, at the gate of the temple of Yahweh. A proclamation was then issued in Judah and Jerusalem that they should bring to Yahweh the tax that Moses the servant of God had required of Israel in the desert. All the officials and all the people brought their contributions gladly, dropping them into the chest until it was full. Whenever the chest was brought in by the Levites to the king's officials and they saw that there was a large

amount of money, the royal secretary and the officer of the chief priest would come and empty the chest and carry it back to its place. They did this regularly and collected a great amount of money. The king and Jehoiada gave it to the men who carried out the work required for the temple of Yahweh. They hired masons and carpenters to restore Yahweh's temple, and also workers in iron and bronze to repair the temple.” (2 Chronicles 24:1-12)

“All the silver and gold and the articles of bronze and iron are sacred to Yahweh and must go into his treasury.” (Joshua 6:19)

“Then they burned the whole city and everything in it, but they put the silver and gold and the articles of bronze and iron into the treasury of Yahweh's house.” (Joshua 6:24)

“Any who had precious stones gave them to the treasury of the temple of Yahweh in the custody of Jehiel the Gershonite.” (1 Chronicles 29:8)

An Israelite was to be put to death for disobeying a priest (Deuteronomy 17:8-12), and the priest's word had equal power even when visiting a town he'd never been in (Deut 18:1-8). His word was law. In the same way that Joseph was second only to the pharaoh, who was seen as a god by the Egyptians; the Israelite priest was second only to God in the eyes of *his* followers.

This is the position planned for the Israelites over the rest of the world's population.

“Now therefore, if you will obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my own possession among all peoples ... and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.” (Exodus 19:5-6)

“Then all nations will call you blessed, for you will be a land of delight, says Yahweh of hosts.” (Malachi 3:12)

“Their descendants will be known among the nations ... All who see them will acknowledge that they are a people Yahweh has blessed.” (Isaiah 61:9)

“He has declared that he will set you in praise, fame and honor high above all the nations he has made, and that you will be a people holy to Yahweh your God, as he promised.” (Deuteronomy 26:19)

“Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.” (Isaiah 60:3)

“For the lips of a priest should guard knowledge, and men should seek instruction from his mouth, for he is the messenger of Yahweh of hosts.” (Malachi 2:7)

“Many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek Yahweh of hosts in Jerusalem...” (Zechariah 8:22)

“Aliens shall stand and feed your flocks, foreigners shall be your plowmen and vinedressers; but you shall be called the priests of Yahweh, men shall speak of you as the ministers of our God; you shall eat the wealth of the nations, and in their riches you shall glory. Instead of your shame you shall have a double portion ...” (Isaiah 61:5-7)

“Many nations will come and say, “Come, let us go up to the mountain of Yahweh, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths.” The law will go out from Zion, the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem.” (Micah 4:2)

“And many nations shall join themselves to Yahweh in that day, and shall be my people; and I will dwell in the midst of you, and you shall know that Yahweh of hosts has sent me to you.” (Zechariah 2:11)

“Then every one that survives of all the nations that have come against Jerusalem shall go up year after year to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, and to keep the feast of booths.” (Zechariah 14:16)

“The nations shall see your vindication, and all the kings your glory; and you shall be called by a new name which the mouth of Yahweh will give.” (Isaiah 62:2)

“If cases come before your courts that are too difficult for you to judge - whether bloodshed, lawsuits or assaults ... go to the priests, who are Levites, and to the judge who is in office at that time. Inquire of them and they will give you the verdict. You must act according to the decisions they give you at the place Yahweh will choose. Be careful to do everything they direct you to do. Act according to the law they teach you and the decisions they give you. Do not turn aside from what they tell you, to the right or to the left. The man who shows contempt for the judge or for the priest who stands ministering there to Yahweh your God must be put to death.” (Deuteronomy 17:8-12)

8) The Israelite Religion Will Be International, Supreme and Permanent

“The nations you will dispossess listen to those who practice sorcery or divination. But as for you, Yahweh your God has not permitted you to do so.” (Deuteronomy 18:14)

“You shall surely destroy all the places where the nations whom you shall dispossess served their Gods, upon the high mountains and upon the hills and under every green tree...” (Deuteronomy 12:2)

“...I will banish the names of the idols from the land, and they will be remembered no more, declares Yahweh Almighty.” (Zechariah 13:2)

“Yahweh will be awesome to them when he destroys all the gods of the land...” (Zephaniah 2:11)

“The arrogance of man will be brought low and the pride of men humbled; Yahweh alone will be exalted in that day, and the idols shall utterly pass away. And men shall enter the caves of the rocks and the holes of the ground, from before the terror of Yahweh, and from the glory of his majesty, when he rises to terrify the earth. In that day men will cast forth their idols of silver and their idols of gold, which they made for themselves to worship, to the moles and to the bats, to enter the caverns of the rocks and the clefts of the cliffs, from before the terror of Yahweh, and from the glory of his majesty, when he rises to terrify the earth.” (Isaiah 2:17-21)

9) The Israelite Legal System Will Be International, Supreme and Permanent:

“Then the nations will know that I, Yahweh, sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary is in the midst of them for evermore.” (Ezekiel 37:28)

“...and David’s throne will remain secure before Yahweh forever.” (1Kings 2:45)

“Arise, O God, judge the earth; for to you belong all the nations!” (Psalm 82:8)

“All the nations thou hast made shall come and bow down before thee, O Lord, and shall glorify thy name.” (Psalm 86:9)

“For out of Zion shall go forth the law and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem. He [the messiah-king of Israel] shall judge between many peoples, and shall decide for strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they train for war any more...” (Micah 4:2-3)

“I will gather all the nations and bring them down to the valley of Jehoshaphat, and I will enter into judgment with them there, on account of my people and my heritage Israel, because they have scattered them among the nations, and have divided up my land...” (Joel 3:2)

“Let the nations bestir themselves, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat; for there I will sit to judge all the nations round about.” (Joel 3:12)

“At that time Jerusalem shall be called the throne of Yahweh, and all nations shall gather to it, to the presence of Yahweh in Jerusalem, and they shall no more stubbornly follow their own evil heart.” (Jeremiah 3:17)

“Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of Yahweh has risen upon you. For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but Yahweh will arise upon you, and his glory will be seen upon you. Lift up your eyes round about, and see; they all gather together, they come to you; your sons shall come from far, and your daughters shall be carried in arms. The sons of those who oppressed you shall come bending low to you; and all who despised you shall bow down at your feet; they shall call you the City of Yahweh, the Zion of the Holy One of Israel ... You shall suck the milk of nations, you shall suck the breast of kings; and you shall know that I, Yahweh, am your Savior and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob...” (Isaiah 60:1-5, 10, 11-12, 14, 16)

14) Top Position for The Israelites

“In that day the root of Jesse shall stand as an ensign to the peoples; him shall the nations seek, and his dwellings shall be glorious.” (Isaiah 11:10)

“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.” (Jeremiah 1:5)

“Behold, you shall call nations that you know not, and nations that knew you not shall run to you, because of Yahweh your God, and of the Holy One of Israel, for he has glorified you.” (Isaiah 55:5)

And you, O tower of the flock, hill of the daughter of Zion, to you shall it come, the former dominion shall come, the kingdom of the daughter of

But they do not know the thoughts of Yahweh, they do not understand his plan, that he has gathered them as sheaves to the threshing floor. Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion, for I will make your horn iron and your hoofs bronze; you shall beat in pieces many peoples, and shall devote their gain to Yahweh, their wealth to Yahweh of the whole earth." (Micah 4:1-3, 8, 11-13)

"And Yahweh will become king over all the earth; on that day Yahweh will be one and his name one. The whole land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. But Jerusalem shall remain aloft upon its site from the Gate of Benjamin to the place of the former gate, to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king's wine presses. And it shall be inhabited, for there shall be no more curse; Jerusalem shall dwell in security. And this shall be the plague with which Yahweh will smite all the peoples that wage war against Jerusalem: their flesh shall rot while they are still on their feet, their eyes shall rot in their sockets, and their tongues shall rot in their mouths. And on that day a great panic from Yahweh shall fall on them, so that each will lay hold on the hand of his fellow, and the hand of the one will be raised against the hand of the other; even Judah will fight against Jerusalem. And the wealth of all the nations round about shall be collected, gold, silver, and garments in great abundance. And a plague like this plague shall fall on the horses, the mules, the camels, the asses, and whatever beasts may be in those camps. Then every one that survives of all the nations that have come against Jerusalem shall go up year after year to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, and to keep the feast of booths. And if any of the families of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, there will be no rain upon them. And if the family of Egypt do not go up and present themselves, then upon them shall come the plague with which Yahweh afflicts the nations that do not go up to keep the feast of booths. This shall be the punishment to Egypt and the punishment to all the nations that do not go up to keep the feast of booths. And on that day there shall be inscribed on the bells of the horses, "Holy to Yahweh". And the pots in the house of Yahweh shall be as the bowls before the altar; and every pot in Jerusalem and Judah shall be sacred to Yahweh of hosts, so that all who sacrifice may come and take of them and boil the flesh of the sacrifice in them. And there shall no longer be a trader in the house of Yahweh of hosts on that day." (Zechariah 14:9-21)

"For who is God, but Yahweh? ... He trains my hands for war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze ...I pursued my enemies and overtook them; and did not turn back till they were consumed. I thrust them through, so that they were not able to rise; they fell under my feet. For thou didst gird me with strength for the battle; thou didst make my assailants sink under me. Thou didst make my enemies turn their backs to me, and those who hated me I destroyed. They cried for help, but there was none to save, they cried to Yahweh, but he did not answer them. I beat them fine as dust before the wind; I cast them out like the mire of the streets. Thou didst deliver me from strife with the peoples; thou didst make me the head of the nations; people whom I had not known served me. As soon as they heard of me they obeyed me; foreigners came cringing to me. Foreigners lost heart, and came trembling out of their fastnesses. Yahweh lives; and blessed be my rock, and exalted be the God of my salvation, the God who gave me vengeance and subdued peoples under me; who delivered me from my enemies; yea, thou didst exalt me above my

adversaries; thou didst deliver me from men of violence. For this I will extol thee, O Lord, among the nations, and sing praises to thy name. Great triumphs he gives to his king, and shows steadfast love to his anointed, to David and his descendants for ever.” (Psalm 18:31, 34, 37-50)

“Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad for her, all you who love her; rejoice with her in joy, all you who mourn over her; that you may suck and be satisfied with her consoling breasts; that you may drink deeply with delight from the abundance of her glory. For thus says Yahweh: Behold, I will extend prosperity to her like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing stream; and you shall suck, you shall be carried upon her hip, and dandled upon her knees ...and it shall be known that the hand of Yahweh is with his servants, and his indignation is against his enemies. For behold, Yahweh will come in fire, and his chariots like the stormwind, to render his anger in fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire will Yahweh execute judgment, and by his sword, upon all flesh; and those slain by Yahweh shall be many. Those who sanctify and purify themselves to go into the gardens, following one in the midst, eating swine's flesh and the abomination and mice, shall come to an end together, says Yahweh. For I know their works and their thoughts, and I am coming to gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come and shall see my glory, and I will set a sign among them ...and they shall declare my glory among the nations ... And they shall bring all your brethren from all the nations as an offering to Yahweh, upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon dromedaries, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, says Yahweh, just as the Israelites bring their cereal offering in a clean vessel to the house of Yahweh ... From new moon to new moon, and from sabbath to sabbath, all flesh shall come to worship before me, says Yahweh. And they shall go forth and look on the dead bodies of the men that have rebelled against me; for their worm shall not die, their fire shall not be quenched, and they shall be an abhorrence to all flesh.” (Isaiah 66:10-12, 14-19, 20, 23-24)
